DAY 1: Home Cities to Reykjavik, Iceland

Meet your fellow travellers in Toronto as you board your overnight flight to Reykjavik.

DAY 2: Arrive Reykjavik

Welcome to Iceland, the land of the Vikings! On your journey to Reykjavik, make a stop at Viking World, an essential Viking ship museum. Here, you can explore these magnificent vessels up close and even board them, diving into the spirit of the explorers who sailed across the seas. During your visit, enjoy a hearty breakfast to fuel your adventures. Afterward, arrive in Reykjavik, where the rest of the day at your leisure, discovering the charm of this vibrant city.

DAY 3: Reykjavik

Experience an in-depth City Tour of Reykjavik with a local guide, where you uncover the rich history and visit notable landmarks like Hallgrimskirka. Following the tour, explore the Perlan Museum & Observation Deck, a unique nature museum that highlights the wonders of Iceland. The remainder of the day is yours to freely discover the city's vibrant culture and attractions

DAY 4: Reykjavik to Laugarbakki

This morning we depart Reykjavik and head north into the Húnabing vestra municipality. Stop at Deildartunguhver, Hraunfossar & Barnafossar Waterfalls along the route. We will also stop at the Grábrók Volcano Crater for a very short hike up its wooden stairs to the top for some stunning views of the surrounding area and crater. Before arriving at the hotel, stop at Kolugljúfur Canyon for a quick photo. Dinner tonight is included.

DAY 5: Laugarbakki to Húsavík

Make our way through the farmland of Húnavatnssýsla to the charming fishing village Húsavík. Different from the volcanic, glaciated landscape of the south, Húnavatnssýsla can be considered more like the Scottish Highlands, green and rounded. Stop at Glaumbær Museum to learn about the turf farmhouses, said to have stood on the hill at Glaumbær since the Age of the Settlements, 900AD. Arriving in Húsavík, check into the hotel before our included dinner.

DAY 6: Húsavík to Mývatn

This morning, depart on a Whale Watching Tour at the whale capital of Iceland where there has been a 97% average success rate of whale watching in the last three decades! Depart Húsavík and continue inland to the spectacular Goðafoss Waterfall, with water falling from a height of 40 ft. over a width of 100 ft. Our journey continues through the Tjörnes Peninsula, one of the best-known geological locations of the country and home to the Icelandic Puffin. Dinner is included tonight.

DAY 7: Mývatn to Egilsstaðir

This morning, we head towards the Lava Field Dimmuborgir and the Námaskarð Hot Springs. Afterwards, we make our way to the Dettifoss Waterfall, the second most powerful in Europe, and the Wastelands of Möðrudalur, visiting the highest elevated farm in Iceland, before stopping at the banks of Lagarfljót Glacial River for the night. Dinner tonight is included.

DAY 8: Egilsstaðir to Jökulsárlón Glacier

Today we traverse through the Eastfjords of Iceland, passing through the quaint villages of Reyðarfjörður, Stöðvarfjörður and Djúpivogur. Eastern Iceland has many narrow fjords surrounded by steep cliffs, black sand beaches, boasts the sunniest weather in the country and is filled with some of Iceland's most well-known and loved wildlife. Along the way we visit Petra's Mineral Museum, a unique museum showing the mineral collection and life of Ljósbjörg Petra María. Tonight's Dinner is included.



DAY 9: Jökulsárlón Glacier to Vík

This morning, travel to Europe's biggest glacier, Vatnajökull. Here we take a cruise on the glacier lagoon and drive across the black sand deserts. Travel through the Eldhraun lava flow towards Reynisdrangar and heading towards Vík. Arriving at Vík, we visit Reynisfjara Beach, a world-famous black sand beach surrounded by enormous basalt stacks. Dinner is included tonight.

DAY 10: Vík to Reykjavik

This morning, drive along the southern coast, stopping to see the Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss Waterfalls. Later, we have a special stop at the Friðheimar Tomato Greenhouse for a tour and light lunch. After, we visit the famous Geysir Geothermal area with its Great Geysir and dotted with many other hot springs. Later, visit the massive Gullfoss Waterfall and the National Park of Pingvellir before travelling to Reykjavik.

DAY 11: Reykjavik

This morning is spent relaxing at one of the world's 25 wonders, the Blue Lagoon. Later in the afternoon, enjoy some free time to relax, explore, or do any last-minute shopping. In the evening, enjoy a farewell dinner with all of your travel friends and Tour Directors.

DAY 12: Depart Iceland

This morning you say your goodbyes and transfer to the airport for our flight back to Canada.
